

Introduction

MacAppStuff Decide lets you keep a list of reasons (pros and cons) regarding a decision you have to make. You rate each reason between 1 and 10 to represent how much it means to you, and the app will calculate a result.

You can configure the app to start when your Mac starts, and it resides in the dock. You can also make the app's window hide on start up (just click it's dock icon to show it again).

Decisions are listed in the popup menu at the top left of the screen. The buttons next to that menu allow you to add, remove and edit decisions (edit only shows when a decision is selected).

Once you create a decision you can add reasons (pros and cons) using the +/- buttons beneath the pro/con lists (see elsewhere in this manual for further details).

When you close the app by clicking on the red icon (top left of window) the app doesn't really quit, it hides in it's dock icon. Show the app again by clicking on the dock icon. This feature allows you to start the app when your Mac starts by hide it away in the dock (see Preferences).

Commands

This section discusses the various button and menu commands, where applicable.

Creating a new decision

To create a new decision use the plus button (top of screen) or "New decision" from the File menu (CMD+N).

You must supply description for the decision, and optionally type some notes.

When you have created a decision you can add reasons (pros and cons) to it using the +/- buttons beneath the pro/con lists. See below regarding adding, editing and deleting reasons.

Editing a decision


Select the decision from the popup menu and either click the edit button to the right of the popup menu, or select "Edit decision" from the File menu.

Deleting a decision

Select the decision from the popup menu and either click the - (minus) button next to the popup menu or select "Delete decision" from the File menu.

Create a pro or con reason

Click the + (plus) button beneath the desired pro or con list (or choose "Edit pro/con reason" from the main menu).

Rating  

Reason

A dialog appears where you can rate the reason from 1 to 10. Simply move your mouse over the stars to make a rating, then enter a reason. The rating should indicate the importance of the reason, 1 being the lowest.

Edit a reason (pro/con)

Simply double-click the reason in the pro or con list to edit it.

Delete a reason (pro/con)

Select the reasons you wish to delete in the list you want to delete from and click the - (minus) button beneath the list.

Preferences



Show app window when app starts

When checked, the app's main window is shown whenever you start the app, otherwise it remains hidden and has to be opened via the menu bar drop down menu.

Start app when you start your Mac

When checked, the app will start whenever your Mac is turned on.

Confirm deletions

Will ask you confirm the deletion of events from the list.

Play sound when changing rating stars

If this option is checked, when you glide your mouse over the rating stars in the add/edit reason dialog, a sound will be made.

Trial Limitations

The trial is designed to run for 14 days. After this time you will either need to purchase a license from our website (see below), or remove it from your computer. The trial only allows you to create one decision.

How to buy

If you are truly satisfied with the software and have fully evaluated it for 14 days, you can purchase a license online from our website (go to the product page and click the Buy button).

PayPal handle our payments. You need a working email address to purchase the software. Once you have made your purchase, you will receive an email from PayPal confirming the transaction, and an email from us (usually within 24 - 48 hours) which will include your license and a download link to the software.

Your license becomes void if it is used by someone else to activate the software, if a refund is issued or your payment is fraudulent.
